

The Paseo COMD-19 Procedures

The Governor's office has said that weddings and events are allowed as long as physical distancing measures are followed "as much as possible."

No specific guest count restrictions are mandated.

In an effort to reopen safely, The Paseo has implemented the following procedures based on CDC guidelines and the Event Safety Alliance Reopening Guide. Maintaining a safe and clean environment for visitors, clients and their guests is our highest priority.

- COVID-19 symptoms/expectations sign will be placed at each entrance.
 - A sanitizing station with hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes and tissues is available for guests at all times.
 - Touch-free faucets, soap, hand dryers and hand sanitizer are available at the restroom hand washing stations.
 - Furniture will be set up with appropriate distancing in all areas of the venue as necessary.
- Staff will wear masks when interacting with others during visits, tours and events.
 - Staff will verify that they do not have typical symptoms or high temperature at the start of each shift.
 - Staff will disinfect high touch areas every hour during events and after each visit or tour.
 - Up to 4 people from the same household will be allowed in the tour information room at one time.
 - Tours and visits are scheduled no more than one per hour to limit interaction between groups.





- Stay home if you have any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, fatigue, shortness of breath.
- The Paseo highly recommends but does not require wearing a face mask.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Practice appropriate physical distancing to the extent feasible and avoid crowding especially at the restrooms, buffets and bars.
- If you are at higher risk for severe illness, The Paseo strongly recommends that you don't attend an event. People at higher risk for severe illness include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions.
 - Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.
 - Regularly wash your hands for at least 20 seconds and use hand sanitizer.
 - After leaving, use hand sanitizer. When you get home, wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.



Creative ideas clients can implement or request.

- Customize your seating arrangements by household or to guests' level of comfort. The Paseo can accommodate seating groups as small as 2 and as large as 12 per table.
 - Provide red, yellow, and green wristbands to your guests.

 They will be used to communicate their level of comfort of physical distancing.

 Red: Please stay 6 feet away and do not touch me.

 Yellow: I would love to interact but please do not touch

 and stay out of my personal space.

 Green: I fear nothing, let's hug it out.
 - Plan to have dinner and/or dancing on the lawn where everyone can be surrounded by fresh, moving air.
 - The Paseo can provide touch-free thermometers if you would like to set up and manage a 'welcome' station to check guests.
